




We suggest the following housing options:

Host families: \$500 for Sunday check-ins and Saturday check-outs, breakfasts and dinners except on arrival or departure days

Furnished apartments: \$1,000 to \$1,500 for Sunday check-ins and Saturday check-outs, 1 bedroom or studio, depending on location

Dormitory rooms: \$1,000 for single occupancy and \$800 for doubles, includes breakfasts and dinners on campus

Suite Hotels that range from \$1,500 to \$2,500 per 2 weeks and standard hotel rooms ranging from \$160 to \$500 per night
